Preparation

Below are some tasks that will help to introduce you to knowledge required for the start of the course or to consolidate key GCSE level material.

Watch - The current series of the Great British Sewing Bee

Visit - A range of shops, high end fashion and high street stores. Look at the different designs/ fashions and take some photographs. Create an A3 mood board showing the designs that caught your eye.

Do - Disassemble a tie - take it apart carefully. Use your old school tie or find a tie in a charity shop to use. When you have taken it apart, lay all the pieces on a table or clear surface and take a photograph. Be ready to discuss what you have seen/found.

Reading
